PROPOSITION NO. 2

RESOLVED: That the Board of Education of the Malverne Union Free School District ("District") be hereby authorized to appropriate and expend from the District's Capital Reserve Fund II, heretofore established by the voters of the District on May 20, 2014, an amount not to exceed Four Hundred Thousand Dollars (\$400,000.00) to undertake and perform the following school building improvements, renovations and/or alterations to commence during the 2019-2020 school year ("Project"), substantially as described in a memorandum report prepared by the District's architects ("Report"), on file and available for public inspection in the office of the District Clerk, all at no additional cost to District taxpayers: district – wide site improvements, including (as and where necessary) furnishings, equipment, machinery, demolition and other work required in connection therewith or incidental thereto; provided that the costs of the components of The Project as set forth in the Report may be reallocated among such components if the Board of Education shall determine that such reallocation is in the best interests of the District and no material change shall be made in the scope of the project.

- **4.** It is hereby further determined that **Josephine Bottitta** is hereby declared to be elected to the Board of Education for a full four year term beginning July 1, 2019 to June 30, 2023
- 5. As evidence of the several determinations herein above made pursuant to Section 2034 of the Education Law of the State of New York, as amended, this Board has caused two copies of this resolution to be signed by the members of this Board
