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RESOLUTION TO AUTHORIZE CAPITAL RESERVE FUND ESTABLISHMENT PROPOSITION

WHEREAS, the Board of Education of the Malverne Union Free School District has determined that there is a need to create a capital reserve fund to cover, in whole or in part, the cost of future capital improvements, renovations and/or alterations of School District facilities, as well as future equipment and/or motor vehicles purchases, to be funded with available monies from the District's fund balance and/or reserves, as authorized herein; and

WHEREAS, the Board desires that a proposition be presented to the voters of the School District authorizing the establishment of a capital reserve fund for said purposes; and

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, that the Board hereby authorizes and directs that the following proposition be placed before the voters of the Malverne Union Free School District at the Annual District Meeting to be held between the hours of 7:00 a.m. and 9:00 p.m. on May 19, 2020, at the polling place heretofore established within the District; and that the District Clerk be hereby authorized and directed to give notice of such proposition to be voted at said Annual District Meeting by publishing a notice thereof, four times within the seven (7) weeks next preceding the district election, the first publication to be at least forty-five (45) days before the election, and to have the necessary ballot labels printed for said vote in the form corresponding as nearly as may be with the requirements of the Education Law and the provisions of the voting machine rules of this school district.

PROPOSITION NO.2 (Establishment of Capital Reserve Fund III):

BE IT RESOLVED, that the Board of Education of the Malverne Union Free School District is hereby authorized to establish a capital reserve fund, known as the "Capital Reserve Fund III," at the terms set forth below, in order to fund future capital projects. Any proposed project to be undertaken with these funds will require voter authorization at a future public vote. The Capital Reserve Fund III will not impact the school budget or the tax rate. It will be funded with available monies from the District's fund balance and/or reserves, as authorized herein. The Capital Reserve Fund III will be created in accordance with the provisions of Education Law section 3651, for the purpose of funding future district wide improvements, renovations and/or alterations, including but not limited to construction, renovation, improvement, alteration and/or replacement of district wide facilities Approval to Authorize Capital Reserve Fund Establishment Proposition

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and property, capital improvements related to changes future enrollment, other infrastructure improvements and similar projects, and the purchase or acquisition of equipment and motor vehicles, and associated or incidental work, services and expenses. Such capital reserve fund shall be for a probable term of twelve (12) years and will commence on June 30, 2020 and expire on June 30, 2032. The capital reserve fund will be capitalized in a total amount not to exceed Ten Million Dollars (\$10,000,000), plus interest, during the term of the fund. The source of the funding of the capital reserve fund shall include an annual transfer of surplus money, if any, from the District's General Fund's unassigned fund balance, as may be available as of the end of each fiscal year from June 30, 2020 through and including June 30, 2032, and any other sources permitted by law, including transfers from existing reserves.

B. BOARD RESOLUTION:

ANNUAL ELECTION AND BUDGET VOTE AND PUBLIC NOTICE

BE IT RESOLVED by the Board of Education of the Malverne Union Free School District, as follows:

Section I: The Annual District Meeting and Election of the Malverne Union Free School District shall be held on Tuesday, May 19, 2020 in the gymnasium of the Howard T. Herber Middle School, 75 Ocean Avenue, Malverne, New York. Said Annual District Meeting and Election as set forth in the Notice of said Annual District Election, annexed hereto, shall be held for the purpose of electing one member of the Board of Education; voting upon the 2020-21 proposed school district budget to vote on an expenditure from the District Capital Reserve Fund for the construction of certain capital improvements to school facilities and to vote on any other matter which may regularly be proposed for voting therein accordance with law. <u>Section IV</u>: The District Clerk is hereby authorized and directed to cause notice to be given of said Annual District Election and Budget Hearing in the form

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prescribed above, by publishing the Notice four times within the seven weeks next preceding such Annual District Election, the first publication to be at least forty-five days prior to the said Annual District Election, in *Newsday*, *The Herald, and Noticia* three newspapers having general circulation in said School District, and by giving such other notice as, in her discretion, may be deemed desirable.

<u>Section V</u>: The District Clerk is hereby authorized and directed to rent the necessary voting machines and to have the necessary voting machine ballot labels printed for said voting machines in the form corresponding as nearly as may be with the requirements of the Education Law, and the voting rules of the School District.

Section VI: A Special Meeting of the Board of Education acting as the Board of Canvass shall be held on Tuesday, May 19, 2020, in the gymnasium of the Howard T. Herber Middle School following the closing of the polls for the purpose of accepting and declaring the results of the voting on all matters submitted to the qualified voters at said Annual District Election.

<u>Section VII</u>: This resolution shall take effect immediately

The condensed form of the budget proposition and the text of all other propositions to appear on the voting machines and a detailed statement in writing of the amount of money which will be required for the school year 2020-2021, specifying the purposes and the amount for each, will be prepared and copies thereof will be made available, upon request, to any resident in the district at each school house in the district in which school is maintained between 9:00 a.m. and 3:00 p.m. during the 14 days immediately preceding said election of May 19, 2020, excluding Saturday, Sunday and holidays, and at such annual election.
