NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that pursuant to Executive Order 202.26 of the Governor of the State of New York, the annual meeting of the qualified voters of the Malverne Union Free School District, Town of Hempstead, County of Nassau, will be held remotely on June 9, 2020, at 5:00 p.m. for the transaction of such business as is authorized by law.

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that the Budget Hearing will be held remotely on May 26, 2020 at 7:00 p.m. for the purposes of discussing funds for the proposed 2020-2021 School Budget. The Budget Hearing can be viewed remotely on the District webpage (www.malverne.k12.ny.us)

PLEASE TAKE FURTHER NOTICE that the vote upon the appropriation of necessary funds to meet the necessary expenditures for the school year 2020-2021, on all propositions duly filed with the Board of Education, and to fill one (1) vacancy on the Board of Education shall be held on Tuesday, June 9, 2020. The qualified voters shall fill the following vacancy: the office of Jeanne D'Esposito, current member of the Board of Education which term expires June 30, 2020, and for a new term commencing on July 1, 2020 and expiring on June 30, 2024. The qualified voters shall also vote upon the following propositions:

PROPOSITION NO. 1

Resolved that the proposed Budget of the Malverne Union Free School District of the Town of Hempstead, County of Nassau, State of New York for the fiscal year 2020-2021 be adopted and that the amount of said budget

be raised by tax upon the taxable property of the School District after first deducting the monies available from the State Aid and other sources.

PROPOSITION NO. 2 (Establishment of Capital Reserve Fund III):

BE IT RESOLVED, that the Board of Education of the Malverne Union Free School District is hereby authorized to establish a capital reserve fund, known as the "Capital Reserve Fund III," at the terms set forth below, in order to fund future capital projects. Any proposed project to be undertaken with these funds will require voter authorization at a future public vote. The Capital Reserve Fund III will not impact the school budget or the tax rate. It will be funded with available monies from the District's fund balance and/or reserves, as authorized herein. The Capital Reserve Fund III will be created in accordance with the provisions of Education Law section 3651, for the purpose of funding future district wide improvements, renovations and/or alterations, including but not limited to construction, renovation, improvement, alteration and/or replacement of district wide facilities and property, capital improvements related to changes in future enrollment, other infrastructure improvements and similar projects, and the purchase or acquisition of equipment and motor vehicles, and associated or incidental work, services and expenses. Such capital reserve fund shall be for a probable term of twelve (12) years and will commence on June 30, 2020 and expire on June 30, 2032. The capital reserve fund will be capitalized in a total amount not to exceed Ten Million Dollars (\$10,000,000), plus interest, during the term of the fund. The source of the funding of the capital reserve fund shall include an annual transfer of surplus money, if any, from the District's General Fund's unassigned fund balance, as may be available as of the end of each fiscal year from June 30, 2020 through and including June 30, 2032, and any other sources permitted by law, including transfers from existing reserves.

PLEASE TAKE FURTHER NOTICE that the condensed form of the budget proposition and the text of all other propositions to appear on the voting machines and a detailed statement in writing of the amount of money which will be required for the school year 2020-2021, specifying the purposes and the amount for each, will be prepared and copies thereof will be made available on the District website, <u>http://www.malverne.k12.ny.us/</u>, during the 14 days preceding said election of June 9, 2020, and on the day of such election.

PLEASE TAKE FURTHER NOTICE that pursuant to Section 495 of the Real Property Tax Law, the district is required to attach to its proposed budget an exemption report. Said exemption report, which will also become part of the final budget, will show the total assessed value on the final assessment roll used in the budgetary process is exempt from taxation, list every type of exemption granted by the statutory authority, and show the cumulative impact of type of exemption, the cumulative amount expected to be received as payments in lieu of taxes and the cumulative impact of all exemptions granted.

PLEASE TAKE FURTHER NOTICE that individuals interested in running for the Board of Education must declare themselves to be a candidate for the Board of Education, provided that they meet all the other legal requirements of candidacy. A candidate may submit a letter in which the individual declares his or her candidacy, or the individual may complete and return the top portion of the candidate petition declaring themselves to be a qualified candidate. Such letter or petition must be filed with the District by mail addressed to the District Clerk, Administration Building, 301 Wicks Lane, Malverne, N.Y., or by email lridley@malverne.k12.ny.us, and received no later than 5:00 p.m. on May 11, 2020. The letter or petition must set forth, at a minimum, the name and residence of the candidate and must describe the specific vacancy for which the candidate is nominated, including the length of term of office and name of the last incumbent. No person shall be nominated for more than one separate office. A nomination may be rejected by the Board of Education if the candidate is ineligible for the office or declares his unwillingness to serve.
